DECLARATION OF LEEMORE KUSHNER

I, Leemore Kushner, declare as follows:

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I am an attorney duly admitted to practice before this Court. I am a
 principal in the law firm Kushner Law Group, attorneys of record for Plaintiff
 Malibu Media, LLC. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein, except
 as to those stated on information and belief and, as to those, I am informed and
 believe that they are true. If called as a witness, I could and would competently
 testify to the matters stated herein. I make this declaration in support Plaintiff's
 Motion for Leave to Serve Third Party Subpoenas Prior to a Rule 26(f) Conference.

10 2. Plaintiff has only named Doe defendants in this action because the
11 identities of the Doe defendants are unknown to Plaintiff at this time.

12 3. Plaintiff cannot serve the Complaint until it conducts discovery into the
13 identities of the persons associated with the Internet Protocol ("IP") addresses in
14 Exhibit A to the Complaint. Plaintiff also cannot conduct a Rule 26(f) conference
15 without knowing the names and contact information of the Doe defendants.

16 4. Each IP address is associated with a particular individual and the
17 discovery sought will facilitate identification of the defendants and service of
18 process.

19 5. The Internet Service Providers ("ISPs") will not suffer any material
20 prejudice by being served with Rule 45 subpoenas that require the ISPs to provide
21 the names and contact information of some of its customers. Plaintiff's discovery is
22 limited in terms of the type of information sought.
