## **Order**

This case was filed against seventeen John Doe Defendants on June 28, 2011. - 1) Defendant Sumita Sen is hereby dismissed from this action with prejudice;
- 2) Defendant Paul Lahaye is hereby dismissed from this action without prejudice;
- 3) The Clerk **CLOSE** this case; and
- 4) The Clerk transmit a copy of this Order to all parties of record.
