ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The matter is before me on the **Plaintiff's Notice of Settlement and Voluntary Dismissal With Prejudice of Doe 9** [#24]¹ filed October 25, 2012. After reviewing the notice and the record, I conclude that the notice should be approved, that plaintiff's claims against John Doe 9, which claims were initially dismissed without prejudice, see [#22], should now be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:



2. That plaintiff's claims against John Doe 9 are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**; and
