ORDER OF DISMISSAL AS TO DEFENDANT NZEYIMANA TITE, ONLY

Blackburn, J.

The matter is before me on plaintiff's **Notice of Voluntary Dismissal With Prejudice of Defendant Nzeyimana Tite** [#34]¹ filed February 1, 2013. After reviewing the notice and the file, I conclude that the notice should be approved and that plaintiff's claims against defendant Nzeyimana Tite should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That plaintiff's **Notice of Voluntary Dismissal With Prejudice of Defendant Nzeyimana Tite** [#34] filed February 1, 2013, is **APPROVED**;
2. That plaintiff's claims against defendant Nzeyimana Tite are **DISMISSED**
