18 1. Pursuant to this Court’s Order (ECF 30), Plaintiff hereby files this status report.

19 2. On April 29, 2011, the Plaintiff served copies of this Court’s Order, a subpoena  
20 requesting certain Internet subscriber information, as well as a letter explaining the requirements  
21 of the subpoena and Court Order on Charter Communications, Clearwire Corporation, Comcast  
22 Cable, Cox Communications, Earthlink, Insight Communications Company, Optimum Online,  
23 Qwest Communications, RCN Corporation, Time Warner d/b/a Road Runner, Verizon Internet  
24 Services, Wide Open West, and Windstream Communications.

25 3. On May 3, 2011, RCN Corporation informed Plaintiff that subpoenas to their company  
26 must be made out to RCN Telecom Services of New York, LP. Plaintiff corrected the subpoena  
27 and sent a new package with the Court’s Order, updated subpoena, and letter regarding the  
28 requirements of the subpoena to RCN Telecom Services of New York, LP, on May 9, 2011.

1 4. On May 3, 2011, Time Warner d/b/a Road Runner replied with objections to the  
2 subpoena.

3 5. On May 4, 2011, Plaintiff issued an updated subpoena package to Windstream  
4 Communications, Inc., to their Los Angeles location.

5 6. On May 26, 2011, Clearwire Corporation notified Plaintiff that it was unable to locate  
6 any responsive records. As such, no subscriber notices were sent out.

7 7. On June 1, 2011, Wide Open West provided subpoena responses to the Plaintiff. On June  
8 2, 2011, Charter Communications provided subpoena responses to the Plaintiff. On June 7,  
9 2011, Insight Communications Company provided subpoena responses to the Plaintiff. On  
10 October 21, 2011, Comcast Cable provided subpoena responses to the Plaintiff.

11 8. While Plaintiff has asked the remaining ISPs to verify the date that notification was  
12 issued to each subscriber, the Plaintiff is still waiting to receive a response.

13 9. Currently, the Plaintiff has received subpoena responses from Charter Communications,  
14 Clearwire Corporation, Comcast Cable, Insight Communications Company, Time Warner d/b/a  
15 Road Runner, and Wide Open West.

16 10. Should the Plaintiff be able to verify the date the remaining ISPs sent out notification,  
17 Plaintiff will file a supplemental report.

18 11. At this point, in light of a recent ruling in Case No. 11-cv-651-IEG-JMA in the Southern  
19 District of California at ECF 29, Plaintiff is considering dismissing this action against any Does  
20 who do not appear to be in California and refiling against remaining Does in their presumed  
21 home jurisdictions or appealing the recent ruling to the 9th Circuit.


