PLAINTIFF’S NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

Plaintiff, pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, hereby dismisses without prejudice all causes of action in the complaint against the Doe Defendants associated with the Internet Protocol addresses listed in Exhibit A to this Notice of Dismissal. Plaintiff is so dismissing because the parties have reached a mutually satisfactory resolution of their differences, the Defendants’ respective Internet Service Providers deleted the relevant Internet Protocol address records before Plaintiff was permitted to issue a subpoena, or, based on information revealed in discovery, Plaintiff intends to file in an alternate District to avoid any apparent jurisdictional issues. The respective Defendants have filed neither an answer to the complaint nor a motion for summary judgment with respect to the same. Dismissal under Rule 41(a)(1) is therefore appropriate.
